SCHEDULE "A" - Conditions:

1. Posters may not be displayed more than two (2) weeks prior to the date of the event (date to be displayed on the posters).
2. Election (National, Provincial, Local and bi-Election) may only be displayed from the date officially announced until the Election Day, after which the posters must be removed within seven (7) days.
3. If the posters are not associated with a specific date / event may only be displayed for thirty (30) days.
4. Posters should be posted on a hard material and tide rope with, plastic-coated wire or "cable ties". No bare wire may be used.
5. Posters must be kept in a neat and orderly state at all times.
6. Posters may contain not slogans or signs offensive or defamatory to the general public, and council reserves the right to request the applicants to remove such posters or broken posters to remove forthwith or be removed for the account of the application (s).
7. Posters may only be attached to street lights and may not appear lower than 250cm will not appear on the pole. Posters may not be attached to trees and / or traffic signs.
8. Attachment of posters on streetlights are limited to a maximum of one (1) poster per pole per applicant.
9. Posters may not appear that it infringes on the safety of motorists or pedestrians, to municipal property will not suffer, damages any such poster will be removed immediately by council staff for the account of the applicant (s).
10. The Applicant (s) indemnify the Council against any claims arising out of the display / attachment of the posters, and may be against the Council instituted.
11. Posters may only be affixed to street lights in the following streets:

12. A deposit is set by the council (currently R250), from time to time and for a maximum of one hundred (100) posters, to be deposited to Council before any posters are displayed. Said deposit is refundable if -
 - 12.1. in the case of paragraph 1 above, all posters are removed (s) to the satisfaction of Council within two (2) days of the event that is displayed on the posters;
 - 12.2. In the case of paragraph 2 above, all posters are removed (s) to the satisfaction of the Board is removed within seven (7) days after the expiration of the period mentioned;
 - 12.3. Under no circumstances may the ropes / fastening material be dismantled and must properly be removed with ropes / fastening material.
 - 12.4. Any damage caused to municipal property due to the installation / removal of the posters;
 - 12.5. fully complied with all conditions stated above;
 - 12.6. If the number of posters, as indicated on the application form, matches the number of posters actually displayed;
 - 12.7. If the Applicant (s) fails to meet any of the above provisions, the Applicant (s) will forfeit the full deposit.
